Welcome to the Redmond Middle School 6th Grade Musical, *Disney Aladdin JR*! The PTSA is pleased to present this production with Youth Theatre Northwest. The musical is open to 6th grade RMS students, as well as 6th grade students whose home school is RMS who are homeschooled or attend another Lake Washington School District school.

Applications for 50 on-stage parts will be accepted and due on Friday, January 12 by 2:30 pm. Students who submit an application with payment and/or scholarship request on January 12 will be guaranteed an on-stage part in the show.

**There is a \$100 fee to participate due with the application.
PTSA scholarships are available.**

Auditions and callbacks will be January 29 - February 1 to assign cast members to specific roles. Rehearsals will be after school on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday (2:30 – 5:30), and Wednesday (1:00 – 4:00). All rehearsals are at Redmond Middle School. A call schedule will be emailed by Thursday for the upcoming week.

Please read through all the information with parents before deciding if this commitment is right for you. Although the rehearsal schedule may appear long, it is important that you can attend all rehearsals. Limited conflicts are allowed during the rehearsal period; however, no conflicts are allowed March 12-24. There is also a commitment from parents to join the PTSA, chaperone at least 3 hours per student, plus [join a committee](#) to help with the production.

6th Grade Musical Participation Policy

Application	Application forms will be available at the parent meeting, Attendance Office, and PTSA website. The application form and fee due date is Friday, January 12 at 2:30 p.m.
Fee	Fee for on-stage participants is \$100, payable to "RMS PTSA". Fee or scholarship request must be turned in with the application form to ensure a spot. The fee is non-refundable after the audition.
Scholarships	We do not turn any student away because of an inability to pay. If you wish to request a full or partial scholarship, please indicate this on the application form. Requesting a scholarship will not have any effect on eligibility for roles in the show. Only the parent producer and a PTSA board representative will know which students have requested scholarships.
Student Time Commitment	<p>Please consider the time commitment before submitting the application. The production conflicts with 3rd season sports. The production begins with auditions the week of January 29 and continues until the performances on March 24. Rehearsals are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday (2:30 – 5:30) and Wednesday (1:00 – 4:00). All students will not be "called" to attend all rehearsals. In addition to rehearsals, student actors are requested to set aside approximately 1-3 hours/week outside of rehearsal to memorize lines, practice songs, block and dance.</p> <p>There will be two performances: March 24 at 2:30 and 6:30 p.m., both in the RMS Commons. Students will report to RMS up to 2 hours prior to show time and will remain at RMS until approximately 8:30 p.m.</p>
Audition	<p>A student's commitment during the first week will be to attend a 60-minute audition (January 29 or 30) and callback (January 31). Cast member callback attire includes clothing and shoes that can be worn to dance. Select cast members may be requested for a second callback on February 1. Casting will be announced in email on Friday, February 2.</p> <p>Students will come prepared to the audition with the audition form, a memorized monologue of no more than 2 minutes to act for the director, and sing a verse and chorus from a song (a capella). Broadway songs are preferred; however, "Happy Birthday" is also an option.</p> <p>The audition form is different from the application form in this packet, and will be available at the parent meeting on January 9, as well as on the PTSA website.</p>
Parent Time Commitment	A mandatory parent meeting will be on January 9 from 6:00 – 7:00 pm in the RMS Library. We require a minimum of 3 chaperoning hours per family for each student, plus participation on a production committee (tickets, concessions, star grams, graphic design, programs, publicity, costumes, makeup and hair, cast party, photography, sets and props, and tech sound and lights). Committee assignments can accommodate both working and at-home parents. Parent volunteers must be PTSA members.
